## LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT

## VOTER ENGAGEMENT SERVICES

- 1. Train-the-trainer voter registration** — We can offer one-on-one or small group trainings to people who want to do third-party voter registration events or help others register to vote.
- 2. Tabling for voter registration** — Our volunteers will bring materials and set up a table to help people register to vote and answer their questions.
- 3. Get Out The Vote Organizing** — We teach relational organizing centered around getting out the vote by teaching people how to effectively communicate within their personal networks.
