## LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT

- **1. Youth Council** A group of young people interested in democracy, who work with the League of Women Voters to organize their peers and take action. Learn more.
- **2. Fellowships & Internships** Internships in voter engagement, voter education, and youth voter outreach are available. Internships require a few flexible hours a week working in support of League projects, and interns receive a small stipend. <u>Learn more</u>.
