**VOTER'S SIGNATURE.** Must sign and date the card.

#### VOTER ID.

- Maine Driver's License # or Maine ID #: New voters who have a valid I.D. must list one of these numbers.
- **Social Security Number:** New voters who do not have a Maine license or I.D. must list the last 4 digits of their SSN.
  - **None:** Only voters who do not have a Maine license, I.D., or SSN, must write "None."

- **REGISTRATION BY MAIL.** New voters who register by mail must provide a copy of their I.D. (e.g. Maine Driver's License) with the registration card and a document showing their address.
  - Many kinds of photo I.D. will work, including student and tribal I.D., state I.D.s, and U.S. passports.
  - A piece of mail can show your address.
