The November 2023 election is an important one. With 8 referendum questions appearing on the ballot, voters deserve access to quality information so that they can make informed decisions.

Vote411.org is used by Mainers to see what will be on their local ballot. Users can watch candidate forums, read candidate questionnaires, and see nonpartisan descriptions of questions appearing on their ballot. It all comes together thanks to a dedicated team of volunteers and staff support.

With Vote411.org, we are the first organization to cover every election in Maine.



OUR THREE GOALS FOR MAINE'S DEMOCRACY

7.

Everyone Votes: Approach 100% voter turnout.

Our short-term goal is to break the 2020 record for turnout in the 2024 election

2.

Everyone Participates, and Everyone's Participation Matters: Ensure everyone has the skills, knowledge, and opportunities for meaningful participation in democratic self-governance, and that government is responsive to all voices.

Our short-term goals are to strengthen trust in democracy by combating misinformation, expanding access to information about local politics and government, and advancing policies that result in more representative voting systems that build power in marginalized communities.

3.

Everyone Means Everyone: Reduce and eliminate inequities in voter turnout and public participation.

Our short-term goal is to register and turnout newly-eligible youth and immigrant voters in 2023, building a habit of voting and strengthening civic engagement skills in these communities.





GETTING THE WORD OUT

Reaching undeserved and remote communities across Maine, which may have limited access to internet and broadband, requires creative strategies to overcome these barriers. Voters have the right to access good, nonpartisan information ahead of elections. We're here to fill in the gaps.



Vote411.org

Drive traffic to the online voter database created by the League of Women Voters.

Approx. 80 hours of staff time Cost = \$2,400

Requires significant staff time to research, collect data, and upload information to the database.



Digital Ads

Place digital ads across Facebook and Instagram to increase traffic to Vote411.org. Approx. 4 week campaign Cost = \$500 (per town)

Digital ads can go a long way on Facebook and Instagram.



Posters

Professionally print and distribute posters (sized 11x17" or larger) to common public spaces.

Approx. 1,000 posters Cost = \$450

Use local companies to professionally print our materials.



Postcards

Professionally print and mail postcards with general, nonpartisan voting and candidate information.

Approx. 7,500 postcards + mailing Cost = \$3,600

Use local companies to professionally print our materials.



Newspaper Ads

Work with local newspaper to print half/full size ads, encouraging readers to visit Vote411.org.

Full page + full color Cost = \$3,600

Half page + full color Cost = \$1,800

Print half/full size ads, in either black/white or full color.





+ ADDITIONAL OUTREACH

MAKE YOUR VOTE COUNT BOOKLETS

We're working to reduce barriers to voting in underrepresented communities. Our **Neighbor to Neighbor** volunteers canvass in their communities with low voter participation, low-income areas, and areas with a high proportion of immigrants. We provide voter information in ten languages including English, and you could help fund these materials.

Cost for "Make Your Vote Count" booklets

500 booklets = \$700 3,000 booklets = \$3,240

REFERENDA FORUMS


