

FUNDRAISING POLICY

07/17/2021 — Amended and re-adopted by LWVME, LWVME Education Fund and Maine Citizens for Clean Elections; 08/07/2021 — Amended and re-adopted by MCCE Action

Fundraising using the names of the League of Women Voters of Maine (LWVME), the LWVME Education Fund, Maine Citizens for Clean Elections (MCCE) and/or MCCE Action (collectively referred to as the organization) is directed toward advancing organizational goals and program priorities and, in the case of the LWVME Education Fund and MCCE, is to be consistent with their tax-exempt purposes.

Board members and Education Fund trustees, in their official capacity or in their work for other entities, shall not use the organization's member list to solicit donations to other entities except as explicitly approved for organization-directed activities.

The boards of the organization can, at any time, consider giving a direct financial contribution from the organization to a partner entity if our financial situation permits and, in the case of the Education Fund and MCCE, if the contribution is consistent with their tax-exempt purposes.

The organization agrees to protect member information with the same degree of care that it uses to protect its own confidential information, and in any case no less than the degree of care that a reasonably prudent business would exercise under similar circumstances.

On an annual basis the organization may publish a list of members/donors/supporters in an edition of the newsletter following the conclusion of the calendar year. The publication of such information shall, always, be consistent with the LWVME, LWVME Education Fund, MCCE and MCCE Action Privacy Policy. Members/donors/supporters are given the opportunity to remain anonymous.
